

A HISTORY OF BARATON COLLEGE

The institution was started in the year 2007 mainly with the aim of training teachers but in 2012, animal health and production courses were introduced. The animal health and Production department is fully registered by The Kenya veterinary board and The Education department accredited by The Kenya national Examination Council.

The vision of the college is to establish it as centre of excellence with education related studies aimed at developing knowledgeable and skilled human resources for enhancement of transformation and productivity in society.

The mission of the college is to provide high quality and affordable teaching, learning, research and services in environment that enables staff and studies to be practical innovation and in the current world.

The institution has four campuses namely; Baraton campus, which is the main campus, Kapsabet campus in Kapsabet town, Eldoret campus in Eldoret Town and Sosiot campus located in Kericho. Kapsabet campus trains animal health and production in addition to education programme training. The institution has students from all regions of Kenya.

Those who will graduate are as follows:-

- (a) Diploma in teacher education (DTE) who have trained for 3 years and will provide services to secondary schools.
- (b) Primary teacher education (PTE) or p1-who are graduating after successful training for 2years and will provide services to Primary Schools.
- (c) Diploma and certificate in early childhood education and development(ECDE)who have undertaken either a 1 year full time training for Certificate or a 2 year training for the Diploma.
- (d) Diploma in animal health and production who have trained for 3years

- (e) Diploma in animal production who have trained for three years
- (f) Certificate in animal health and production who have trained for two years
- (g) Certificate in animal production and Health Management which is a two years course.

The college is doing its best to ensure the students are equipped with practical skills through collaboration with The Regional veterinary investigation laboratory (VIL) situated at Eldoret, Kaimosi Agricultural training College and The County Government of Nandi. A total number of 305 students will graduate as follows:-

i) Animal Health and production - 129 Graduands

ii) Education Department - <u>176 Graduands</u>
