A few people showed interest in the P1 course and we admitted our First group of the P1 that year. In the same year, we enrolled a few students in ECDE and The Diploma In Teacher Education.

In the year 2012, we introduced Certificate and Diploma courses in Animal Health and Production. This Department is fully registered with The Kenya veterinary board and accredited by The department of Education.

We again in 2017 introduced Business and Technical courses in Artisan, Certificate and Diploma.

The vision of the college is to establish it as a Centre of excellence with education related studies aimed at developing knowledgeable and skilled human resources for enhancement of transformation and productivity in society.

The mission of the college is to provide high quality and affordable teaching, learning, research and services in an environment that enables staff and students to be practical and innovative in the current world.

The institution has four campuses namely;

1. Baraton campus, which is the main campus
2. Kapsabet campus in Kapsabet town
3. Eldoret campus in Eldoret Town and
4. Kericho campus located in Sosiot.

COLLABORATION WITH OTHER UNIVERSITIES

From 2011, we were in collaboration with **Gretsa University - Thika** and we graduated several students with degree/Diploma and Certificate Awards in Education, Business and social sciences.

From 2014, we again had another collaboration with **The Great Lakes University of Kisumu** and also managed to graduate many students with Degree, Diploma and Certificate Awards.

Our most current collaboration is with Kenya Highlands University in Kericho. We have graduated students in the Departments of Education, Business and Social Sciences since 2016 upto date.

We look forward to establishing a university of our own in the near future given the vast experience we have had with the three Institutions of Higher learning.

2020 GRADUATING GROUP:

This graduation is going to be our 11th Graduation Ceremony since the inception of Baraton College.

In this year's graduation, we will not have graduants in the Department of Education specifically the P1, ECDE and The Diploma in Education KNEC Programme. We will only have a smaller group of Diploma in Education under the University Programme.

This is because KNEC Education Exams were delayed due to closure of schools and Colleges due to Covid -19 pandemic. Some KNEC Examinations are currently still Ongoing.

- (a) Diploma in animal health and production who have trained for 3 years
- (b) Diploma in animal production and Health management who have trained for three years
- (c) Certificate in animal health and production who have trained for two years
- (d) Certificate in animal production and Health Management who have trained for two years.

NB: The College is doing its best to ensure the students are equipped with practical skills through collaboration with The Regional veterinary investigation laboratory (VIL) situated at Eldoret, The Kaimosi Agricultural training College and The County Government of Nandi.
